President's Address

Volunteer Banquet and Raffle Tickets – Andrew Flynn stated that the volunteer banquet was an enjoyable evening and he received positive feedback. He acknowledged all the hard work put into the event by Michelle Balcombe, Lise and Rick Morin. Andrew stated that we exceeded our ticket sales goal this year. His goal of us selling 1 book per child registered in our zone was also realized.

Treasurer's Report (Lise)

Lise Morin explained that we have a balance of \$13,206.99. \$4,157.00 is our National reserve fund leaving us with operating capital of \$9,049.99. Lise reported that we had 333 registrations this year which is 40 down from last year.

Steve Patterson brought us up to date on the following:

- **Bill Mackenzie** – Takes place tomorrow **April 24, 2016** at the Orleans Bowling Centre. In discussion it was recognized that tournament entries have dropped. Andrew Flynn offered to chat with Rob Mackenzie and make an offer for the zone to take the tournament over when he is ready to pass it along.

- **Community Coaching Courses – May 1, 2016** @ Arnprior Bowling Center, 120 John Street. Steve stated that they needed 12 participants to run the course.
- **Record Scores** – Steve asked that record scores be submitted as soon as possible so he can compile them and send them off to Bowl Ontario.



Old Business

- **Volunteer Banquet and Raffle Tickets – (April 2, 2016).**

The event took place at Louis Steak House (1682 Cyrville Road) again this year. The cost was \$30 / guest. Michelle stated that she had positive feedback from many. Next year she would like the numbers from the bowling centers 2 weeks in advance along with any special dietary concerns of our guest. In discussion April 1, 2017 was selected as next years' date at the same location.

Action Item: Michelle Balcombe to send raffle ticket and banquet ticket templates to Winnie Spires who has a volunteer that's offered to print them (5,000 raffle / 100 banquet).

Raffle Tickets were distributed to each center, and all but Deep River participated. The money raised in the current year is disbursed the next season as Zone Sponsorship for travel expenses to our coaches/bowlers that are going to Provincial or Nationals. Sales were up this year and we exceeded our goal of \$3000.



New Business

- **10th Annual Strike 13 - Zone Fundraiser** – November 13, 2016 @ Walkley - Important facts to note: Average date October 31, 2016 and entry fee \$20. Andrew has been soliciting help in picking up prizes around the city. Winnie Spires offered to pick up in the west end.
- **2016-17 Season Registration / Promotional Forms:** Andrew Flynn presented an idea he was working on for Walkley as an example and offered to share with other centers for them to customize with their own details. He asked that as the bowling centers forward their 2016-17 Registration Forms to him when completed so he can post them on the Zone X Association website. JR Gorley stated that he was working on material that would be sent out to schools in the facility of Vanier Rec. and he would be willing to work with Andrew to customize them for all areas.
Action Item: Andrew Flynn will update the website as information becomes available. JR Gorley to work with Andrew in regards to material to go out to the schools.
- **Status of West Park for the 2016-17 Season:** Andrew Flynn asked if there was a change in West Park's status next season as they are doing renovations to the bowling center.
Action Item: Steve Patterson will make inquiries to get answers.
- **New Program Director @ Walkley:** Andrew Flynn announced that he would be taking over as the Program Director next season. He has been working with Lise Morin so there is an easy transition.
